



Military Religious Preferences

Update 2014

- 134% increase in Atheist/Agnostic identification
- 20+% decrease in Evangelistic denominations with matching increase in “Non-denominational” category
- 17% increase in ‘other’ religions, but 29% decrease in Wicca
- 2.2M total 2014 population; All branches and components included
