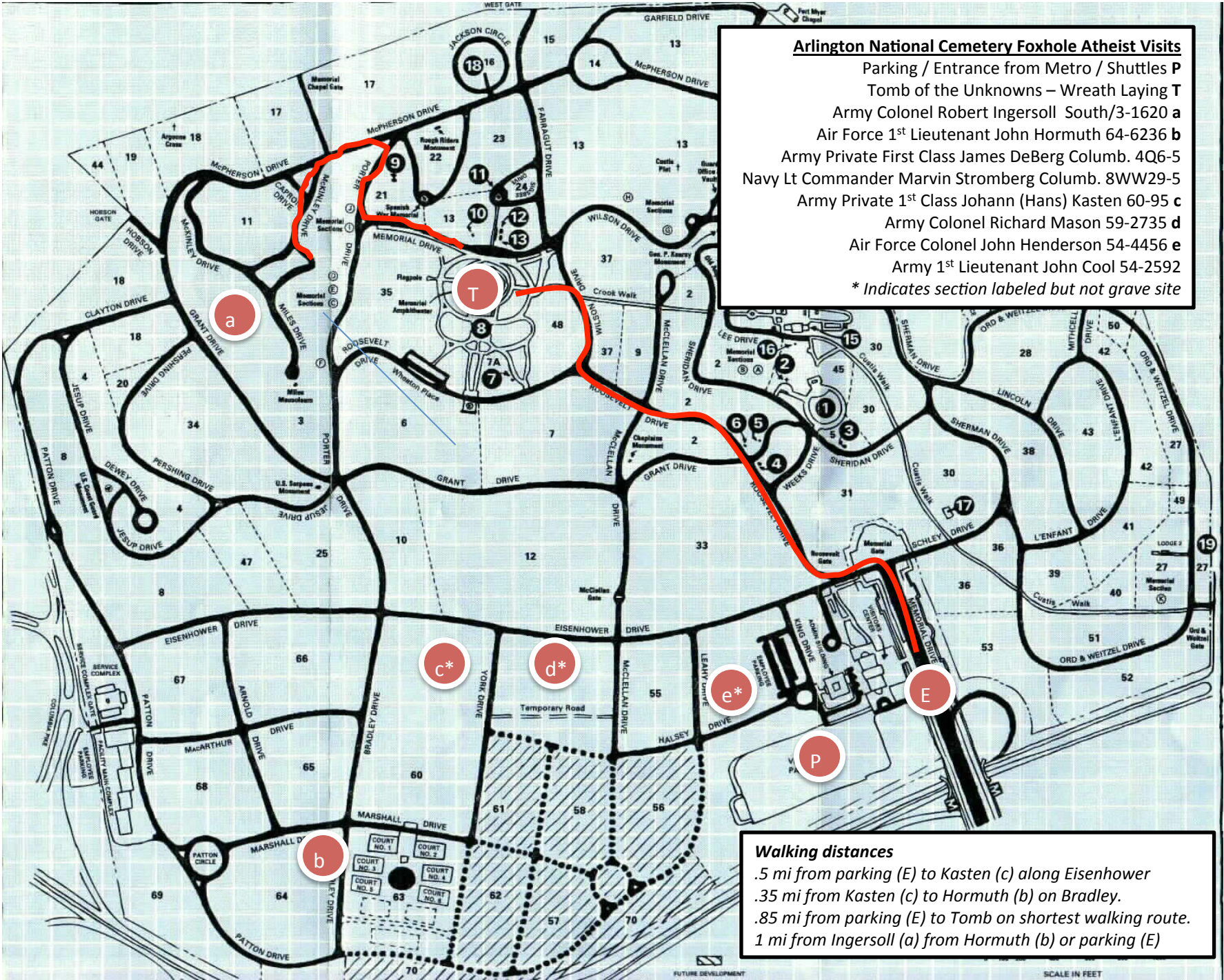

The Military Association of Atheists & Freethinkers invites active military, veterans, and others to celebrate service to the nation and to honor veterans including atheists in foxholes.

The hike currently visits the gravesites of eight known atheists in foxholes. Approximate walking distances are listed on the attached map. Continuing the full walk to all sites and back to the parking lot/metro is about 2 miles.

The Tomb of the Unknowns is a primary destination and often features special events. The Tomb also offers a good starting or ending point for the tour. The Tomb is a 15-minute walk from the entrance or a \$8.75, 10-minute shuttle. Other details regarding shuttles, discounts, the ceremony, parking, directions, and other items are at [arlingtoncemetery.mil](http://arlingtoncemetery.mil). Arlington Cemetery is generally open daylight hours every day (365 days). Also consider the “ANC Explorer” phone App that provides maps and locations for gravesites.

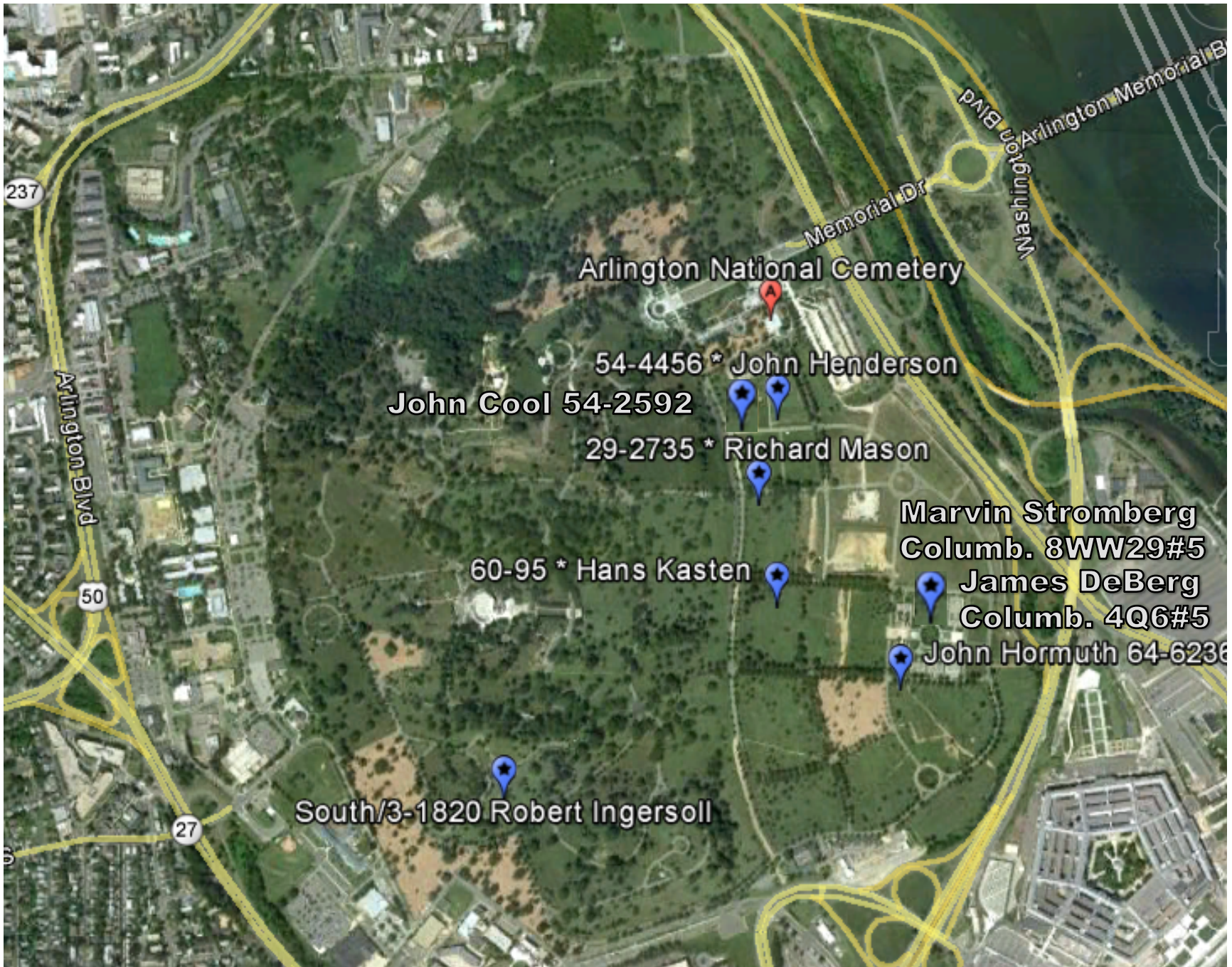

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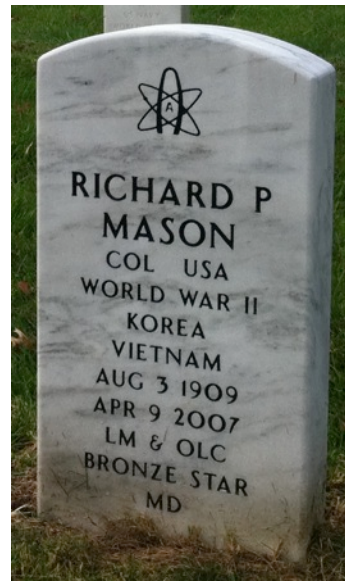

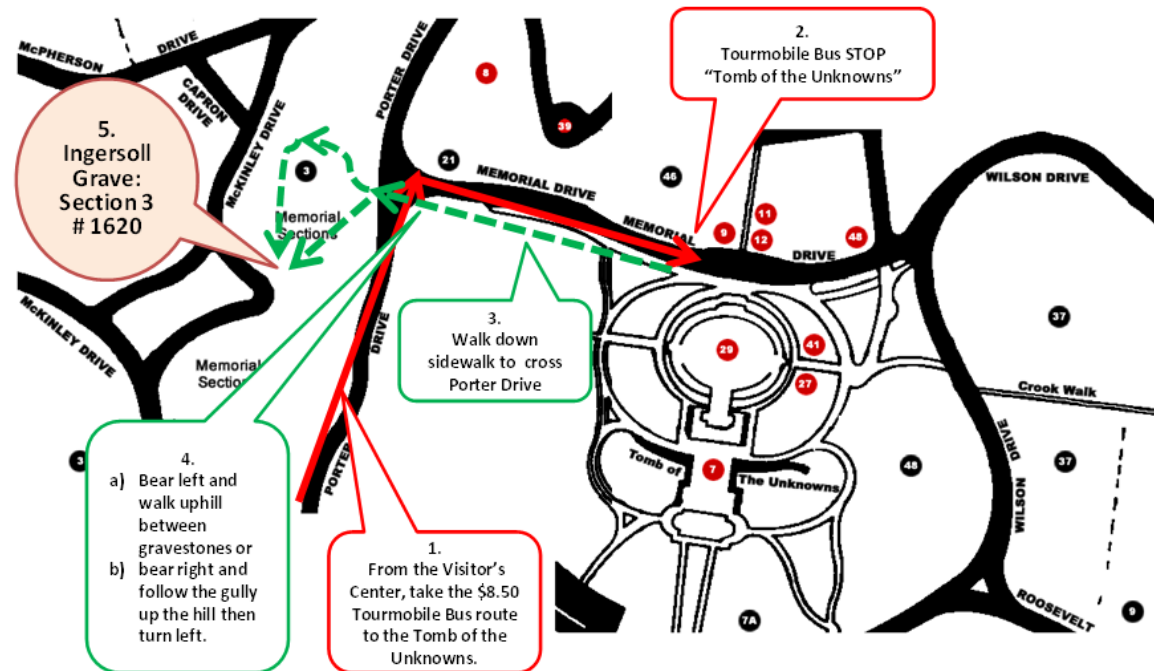
## Ingersoll route by Tourbus/Tomb of the unknowns Courtesy of Steve Lowe

Map to visit the Robert G. Ingersoll grave in Arlington National Cemetery via the Tourmobile bus (\$8.50 ticket) and walking\*.

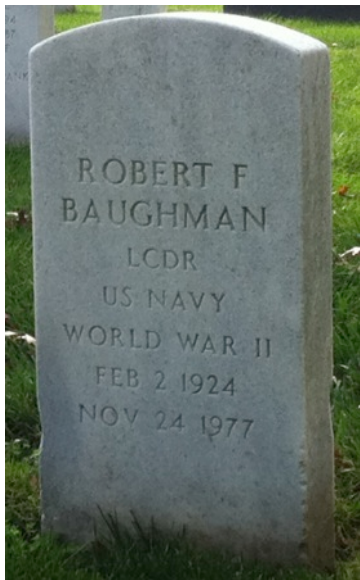
- after disembarking from the bus, about a six minute (200 yard) walk along a sidewalk and then uphill on grass.
- hint: look for the 20 foot tall white obelisk marking a Vanderbilt grave. Ingersoll's is just north of it.



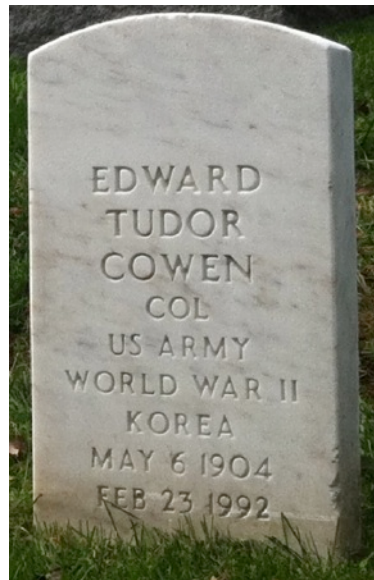
Look for Zmuda in the Miles Dr Circle  
Ingersoll is in line of sight to tall obelisk  
The Ingersoll site is the large marker  
In the red square



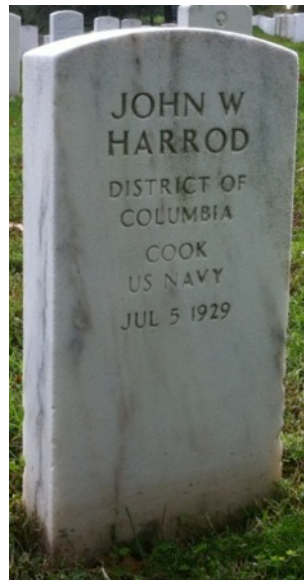




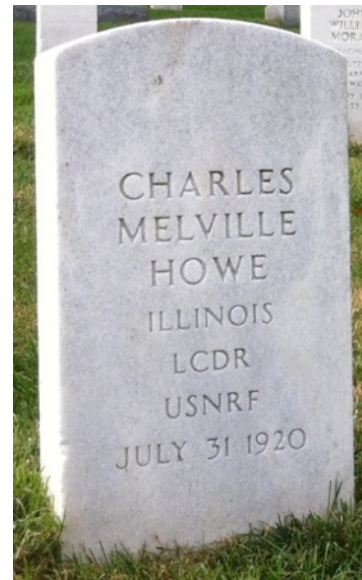

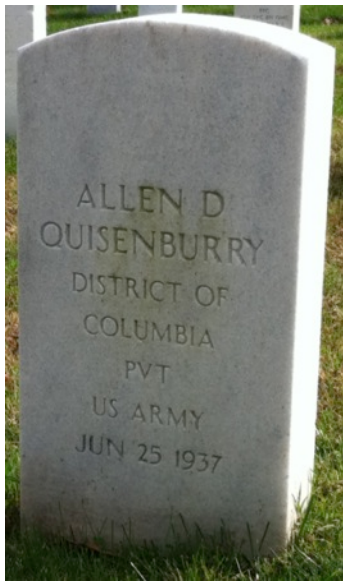


SECTION 2 C E SITE 68

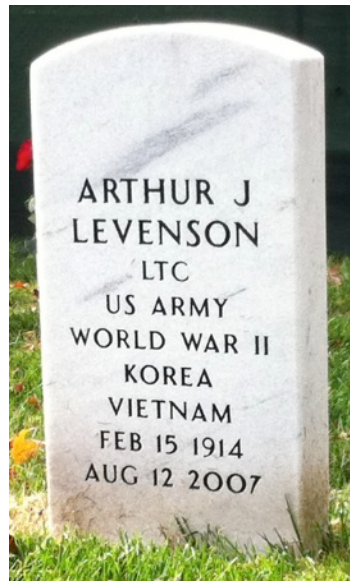

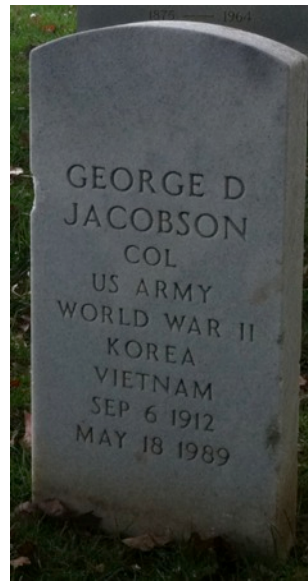
